A meeting of the Louisiana Board of Pardons & Parole met on Wednesday, May 17, 2017 in the Board hearing room located at 504 Mayflower, Baton Rouge, Louisiana. Ms. Sheryl Ranatza, Board Chair, called the meeting at 8:40 A.m.

Public Comment: No public comment was made

Regular Business

Without objection, reading of the minutes of previous Board meeting of April 12, 2017 was dispensed by Board. Motion was made by Mr. Roche', seconded by Mr. Wise to approve the minutes of the April 12, 2017 meeting.

New Business

The board considered and voted on 20 re-applications and 30 applications. The board considered and heard 16 clemency cases. Offender Michelle Hayes #452777 was removed due to no show.

Other Business

- Mr. Loftin made a motion to amend the agenda (Re-review of 3 applicants). All board members voted yes. Motion was approved:
 1. Alvin Mead #310779 (Act 469 eligibility) – Offender Mead requested the Board to rescind his pardon to be eligible for Act 469. Board voted to take no action.
 2. Patrick Courtney #295356 (parole eligibility) – On April 12, 2017, the board voted to commute Offender Courtney's sentence to 99 years. On May 17, 2017, the board had a review of re-application and unanimously voted to commute Offender Courtney's sentence to 99 years **with parole eligibility**.
 3. Charlie Young #116590 (parole eligibility) – On April 12, 2017, the board voted to commute Offender Young's sentence to 99 years. On May 17, 2017, the board had a review of re-application and unanimously voted to commute Offender Young's sentence to 99 years **with parole eligibility**.
