BATON ROUGE, La. - The Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections (DPS&C)

Christopher Sepulvado, age 81, died at approximately 8:45pm, Saturday, February 22, 2025, at the Louisiana State Penitentiary in Angola, Louisiana. He died from natural causes as a result of complications arising from his pre-existing medical conditions.

Christopher Sepulvado has been in the custody of the Louisiana Department of Corrections since May 24, 1993 for a DeSoto Parish conviction of First Degree Murder. On Friday, February 21, 2025, the Department of Public Safety and Corrections Headquarters received an execution warrant for Christopher Sepulvado with an execution date set for March 17, 2025.
