BATON ROUGE, La. – The Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections would like to invite the public to the second annual Rayburn Correctional Center (RCC) Arts and Crafts Show, which will be held on Saturday, May 16 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. The outdoor event will take place on RCC grounds located at 27268 Highway 21 North in Angie.

The individuals who are incarcerated at RCC will have a variety of handcrafted items for sale including porch swings, rocking chairs, paintings, woodworking, leatherwork, and plants.

“Every item is crafted and every plant is nurtured by our skilled and talented inmates,” said Keith Bickham, warden, Rayburn Correctional Center. “We plan to provide more opportunities for the inmates to display and sell their crafts in the future.”

The proceeds from each sale will go toward the inmate’s account which helps them as they prepare to reenter the community. The public is reminded that drugs, alcohol and weapons are not permitted at the correctional facility.

Assorted refreshments will be available for purchase with proceeds benefitting the Bogalusa Help Center, a local food bank that serves more than 400 families each month.
